

Newly launched ACJ TwoTwenty completes first flight

Mirabel, 14 December 2021 – The ACJ TwoTwenty launched just over a year ago, completed its first flight from the Mirabel airport on 14 December 2021. The production test flight was performed by Christophe Marchand and Adam Mason as Test Pilots and supported by Romuald Scheling as Flight Test Engineer.

The aircraft will be delivered to Comlux in the coming weeks and then outfitted with a VVIP cabin by COMLUX in Indianapolis, USA after the delivery. Comlux has been selected as an exclusive outfitting partner for the first 15 ACJ TwoTwenty aircraft.

The ACJ TwoTwenty is a new value proposition to business aviation buyers. The ACJ TwoTwenty is the only business jet featuring six wide VIP living areas, of around 12m²/130 ft² each and is at a price point of a ULR bizjet.
